The fourth in our series on miracles of The Anointed Redeemer!

Matthew 8: Mark 1: Luke 4:

Verse 38 of Luke 4 holds many items of interest for the learner.

1. The Master delivered the demoniac in the synagogue at Capernaum.
2. Peter must have lived close by, for they walked from the synagogue to Peter's house.
3. Simon/Peter was married, had a wife, had a mother-in-law.
4. The people there asked the Redeemer for His help.
5. Mark 1 lets us know Peter, James, Andrew and John were present with The Lord.

The Redeemer takes mom's hand, (Mark 1:31) He rebuked (took dominion over) the spirit of infirmity (Luke 4:39) and immediately she was free from satan's captivity. The fever was broken.

Mother-in-law gets up and begins to serve her guests.

The word spread, The Healer is in the house, people were brought to be set free.

The Redeemer laid hands on them, and they were healed,
Mark 16:18..."hands you will lay, well they will be."

Luke 8:24 rebuked a storm on the Sea of Galilee.

Luke 4:35 and Mark 1:25 rebuked a demon.

The Anointing not only broke the yoke of infirmity, but she was made whole, to the point of being able to serve.
