And yet he never staggered in doubt at the promise of God, on the contrary, his faith gave him strength, and he praised God for this blessing before it even happened.

In the full assurance that God was well able to do what He had promised,

And therefore, his faith was regarded as righteousness

23 It was not on his account alone that these words, "it was credited to him", were written

but also with reference to us. Our faith will also be regarded by God in the same light, if we believe on Him that raised our Lord Jesus from the dead.

Who was delivered unto death because our offenses, and was raised to life for our acquittal (justification).
