“Believe me: I am in my Father and my Father is in me. If you can’t believe that, believe what you see—these works. The person who trusts me will not only do what I’m doing but even greater things, because I, on my way to the Father, am giving you the same work to do that I’ve been doing. You can count on it. From now on, whatever you request along the lines of who I am and what I am doing, I’ll do it. That’s how the Father will be seen for who he is in the Son. I mean it. Whatever you request in this way, I’ll do.

·I tell you the truth [^lTruly, truly, I say to you], whoever believes in me will do the same things that I do. Those who believe will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. [^cThey will do greater things because all believers—not just Jesus—will have the Holy Spirit living in them and empowering them.]

A miracle is directed to an individual.

A sign is used to distinguish or confirm a word or gift (person) set apart by God.

A wonder is something outside the normal realm that causes the beholder to marvel.

John 4:43 (NAS)

After the two days He went forth from there into Galilee.

He left the area of the Samaritans and returned to Galilee.

⁴⁴ For Jesus Himself testified that a prophet has no honor in his own country.

He came to His own, but His own received Him not.

Be ready, when you are busy about the Father’s business, those who are not will Judge, accuse, reject you.

⁴⁵ So when He came to Galilee, the Galileans received Him, having seen all the things that He did in Jerusalem at the feast; for they themselves also went to the feast.

The signs had made a name for Him, His lineage made a place for Him.

⁴⁶ Therefore He came again to Cana of Galilee where He had made the water wine. And there was a royal official whose son was sick at Capernaum.

One with connection to a King (natural).

⁴⁷ When he heard that Jesus had come out of Judea into Galilee, he went to Him and was imploring *Him* to come down and heal his son; for he was at the point of death.

He heard of this King of the Jews. He didn't ask for prayer, He didn't ask for an encouraging word, He asked Yeshua to heal his son!

Are you prepared to do the works He did?

⁴⁸ So Jesus said to him, "Unless you *people* see signs and wonders, you *simply* will not believe."

Natural minded people have to experience something their senses can grasp, in order to believe.

Romans 8:14 (NAS)

For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

The natural mind cannot receive spiritual knowledge.

⁴⁹ The royal official *said to Him, "Sir, come down before my child dies."

Do we see faith, or desperation?

⁵⁰ Jesus *said to him, "Go; your son lives." The man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him and started off.

He spoke as one having authority (Mark 1:22), your faith/trust will become contagious. You must be one with the Truth, for your words to carry the power and presence of The Truth.

Real faith in a Word of the Lord is followed by results.

⁵¹ As he was now going down, *his* slaves met him, saying that his son was living.

Real faith inspires attesting actions.

⁵² So he inquired of them the hour when he began to get better. Then they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him."

Seventh hour – 1:00 P.M.

He is getting confirmation that no accident has occurred.

⁵³ So the father knew that *it was* at that hour in which Jesus said to him, “Your son lives”; and he himself believed and his whole household.

The Nobleman now has confirmation of the power of the Word of a King.

Ecclesiastes 8:4 (NKJV)
Where the word of a king *is, there is* power;
And who may say to him, “What are you doing?”

Who you receive, determines what you can receive.

If you receive a savior –
If you come under Lordship –
If you repent of your sins –
If you receive your King, you come under Royal rule and provision.

Yeshua is Lord –
You are called to be His hands (John 14:12, Ephesians 4:12)
Where do you serve the Kingdom?
