The Voice of Faith

Mark 11:22-24 (NAS)

And Jesus *answered saying to them, "Have faith in God. ²³ Truly I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says is going to happen, it will be *granted* him. ²⁴ Therefore I say to you, all things for which you pray and ask, believe that you have received them, and they will be *granted* you.

Believe in your heart, say, confess, decree and what you say, will come to pass,

Jesus the Christ, said this is how faith works.

The Apostle Paul, one of the great exponents of faith, explained the way faith operates.

Romans 10:8 (NAS)

But what does it say? "THE WORD IS NEAR YOU, IN YOUR MOUTH AND IN YOUR HEART"—that is, the word of faith which we are preaching,

The Word of God on any matter, comes forth from your heart and is released through your mouth. Believe God's Word, speak His Word as <u>your</u> word, and you win, you will have it.

Job 22:28 (NAS)

"You will also decree a thing, and it will be established for you; And light will shine on your ways.

You, person of faith, decree, confess, proclaim, say it and it comes to pass. Then you awaken to, the way things get done in the Kingdom of God. Creation is here, because God said!

2 Corinthians 4:13 (KJV) (Psalm 116:10)

We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;

Here Paul explains the Spirit of Faith:

- I believe (in my heart)
- Therefore because I believe
- I speak say out, decree, confess what I believe

God, Jesus, Job, Paul, the theme seems to be the same, believe what God said, say what you believe, and it will happen, come to pass, come into your possession, manifest, become tangible. (2 Corinthians 4:18)

The wisest man of the Old Covenant explained the power of the tongue to affect the level of one's life.

Proverbs 18:20 (NAS) With the fruit of a man's mouth his stomach will be satisfied; He will be satisfied with the product of his lips.

- You will have food to sustain you, that your tongue has produced.
- You will get a full supply of what your tongue produces (good or bad). You will have a bumper crop of what your tongue creates.

Proverbs 18:21 (NAS) Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

- The power to live is on you, because your tongue speaks life words.
- The ability of death to contain you, is on you because your tongue spoke words of sickness, death, defeat.

The revelation of "the spirit of faith" is clearly stated in the *b*. part of Proverbs 12:6.

NAS: the mouth of the upright will deliver them

NLT: the words of the godly save lives

RSV: the mouth of the upright delivers men NIV: the speech of the upright rescues them

The life of others can be enhanced by the words you speak. Believe the best, speak the best and pass the test of life and death.

The revelation here is that what you say governs the direction of your life.

- your tongue is the steering wheel of your life -

Proverbs 6:2 (AMP)

You are snared with the words of your lips, you are caught by the speech of your mouth.

What you say, as an expression of your heart belief, will liberate or will snare you. The tongue invites life or invites death.

Faith calls (names) things that do not yet appear, as though they already existed (Romans 4:17). Why does a person call their dog, their child, their mate? Because they believe in calling things that are not visible, into the realm of their sight. Faith people believe it on a higher level.

1 Timothy 6:12-13 (NAS)

Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. ¹³ I charge you in the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who testified the good confession before Pontius Pilate,

- Our good confession, the Lordship of the Anointed Redeemer.
- Jesus good confession, all power comes from THE FATHER, and I have His power (10,000). He affirmed He was King and Lord.

Revelation 12:11

NLT: and they defeated him by the blood of the lamb, and by their testimony of truth

NAS: and they overcame him because of the blood of the lamb and because of the Word of their testimony (confession)

AMP: and they have overcome (conquered) him by means of the Blood of the Lamb, and by the utterance of their testimony. (the witness they gave)

What is the formula for defeating the devil?

- 1. You are under the cover of, and in the authority of the all cleansing power of the Blood of Yshuwah.
- 2. Your words agree with God's Word, and you speak out what you believe to be a true witness, or testimony of truth.

The first time a Believer conquered the devil, they did it by saying, giving witness to, testifying of, the Lordship of the Blood donor, because they believed God's Word in their heart.

How did they overcome the sentence of hell, death and torment? What was the first operation of faith in a Believer's life?

Romans 10:9-10 (AMP)

Because if you acknowledge and confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and in your heart believe (adhere to, trust in, and rely on the truth) that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰For with the heart a person believes (adheres to, trusts in, and relies on Christ) and so is justified (declared righteous, acceptable to God), and with the mouth he confesses (declares openly and speaks out freely his faith) and confirms [his] salvation

- With the words of your mouth you say...
- Because you believe in your belly your heart your inner man
- That Jesus Yshuwah Messiah the Anointed Redeemer is Lord of all, because after shedding His sinless Blood, He was raised from the grip of hell, death and torment to prove that the Blood was adequate to defeat darkness, the fall of man and the curse that flowed out of the fall.

The way we get into the Kingdom, is the way we operate in the Kingdom and take possession of all that Kingdom life has in store for the Believer.
