Were you born of God?

Then the divine nature is part of the new you.

2 Peter 1:4 (NAS)

For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of *the* divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.

The divine nature rules over, and exercises authority over creation.

Mark 11:21-24 (NAS)

Being reminded, Peter *said to Him, "Rabbi, look, the fig tree which You cursed has withered." ²² And Jesus *answered saying to them, "Have faith in God. ²³ Truly I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be taken up and cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that what he says is going to happen, it will be *granted* him.

²⁴ Therefore I say to you, all things for which you pray and ask, believe that you have received them, and they will be *granted* you.

Authority to rule over creation.

Take up your divine nature and say to the darkness, "light be".

Put life's challenges under The Word.

Speak to the mountains in your way...

Matthew 17:20 (KJV)

And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

"as", like unto,

It grows, produces and defies its small beginning.

The fruit that comes from the seed, takes time to develop and come to maturity.

The true Believer is like a tree.

Psalm 1:3 (NAS)

He will be like a tree *firmly* planted by streams of water,
Which yields its fruit in its season
And its leaf does not wither;
And in whatever he does, he prospers.

Jeremiah 17:8 (NAS)

“For he will be like a tree planted by the water,
That extends its roots by a stream
And will not fear when the heat comes;
But its leaves will be green,
And it will not be anxious in a year of drought
Nor cease to yield fruit.

A tree planted by a stream, produces shade, refuge, its fruit comes in its season.

There are many stages the tree goes through, from seed, to fruit producing. It draws its strength from the stream.

No stream, no fruit. The flow of the stream is through the tree, to the fruit.

Your fruit comes in your season. Each tree has its season, yours is in line.

Galatians 6:9 (NAS)

Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary.

He is the vine, we are the branches. Connected, His flow is in us, and through us.

From the teaching of our Anointed Redeemer, on the application of faith.

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Faith as a grain of mustard seed. The seed cannot produce a tree until it first draws the essential elements from the earth it is planted in.

John 15:5 (NAS)

I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.

Apart, separated, cut off from the divine flow, you are not capable of or up to the challenges of life.

But:

Colossians 1:27 "it is Christ (Christo – The Anointing) in you, the hope of glory (God's manifest presence).

When God shows up, through you, the giants of opposition fall.

Philippians 4:13 (AMP)

I can do all things [which He has called me to do] through Him who strengthens *and* empowers me [to fulfill His purpose—I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency; I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses me with inner strength and confident peace.]

All that a seed can or will produce, is in the seed, but it takes "outside" of self strength and nourishment to do so.

Your future greatness, ability and development is in you now, but THE ANOINTING, working with and through you, brings it to fullness.
