There are over 250 promises that are given to Believers in the will our Lord left to "them that believe".

By count there are over 700 promises recorded, but since many are repeats, the actual number without repeats is 250.

Many church attendees spend their whole life not knowing what belongs to them.

An inheritance must be believed, laid claim to and received as a personal possession.

What a shame to live one's life and never enjoy what actually belongs to them by divine decree.

John 10:10

"My purpose in coming, is to give them a rich and satisfying life."

"I have come that they might have an abundant and satisfying life."

(AMP)

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

When a person dies and leaves a will, their heirs benefit from its provision. When a person who has died to provide for you, is risen from the dead to act as your lawyer (advocate) to administer the will:

1 John 2:1 (NAS)

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous;

You are doubly blessed!

2 Peter 1:4 (NLT)

And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires.

But to receive the fuller impact, we back up to verse :2 to begin.

:2

May God give you more and more grace and peace as you grow in your knowledge of God and Jesus our Lord.

“Grace and peace are multiplied to the Believer, as you study.”

2 Timothy 2:15 (NAS)

Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.

And as you meditate His Word

Joshua 1:8 (NAS)

This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.

Or, the more you know His Word, the more you can show His Word in operation. “in the knowledge of Jehovah Lord of Hosts and of The Anointed Redeemer, our Lord and King”.

:3

“you come to understand that His divine power (it is written) has granted to us (by inheritance to be laid hold of) everything that pertains to living in abundant life, and to imitating God (as dear children Eph. 5:1) through the true knowledge (rightly interpreting the Word with the Word) of Him who called us by virtue of His own glory and excellence (virtue – anointed flow).

For by these (manifest presence and anointing) He (The Redeemer) has granted (bequeathed) to us (Believers) His precious (to be treasured) and magnificent (perfect) promises (in the will) in order that (By activating) by them (the promises) you (Believer) might become partakers of the divine nature (ruling and reigning over life’s challenges) having escaped being corrupted by the desires of an earthly nature. (GA)

Some New Covenant promises, such as Matthew 8:17 and 2 Peter 2:24 were prophesied as coming in the old will, Isaiah 53:4-5.
